



Skyline PTSA Student Enrichment Grant

Primary Guidelines

- A. Specificity of the enrichment opportunity is clearly outlined and researched including purpose, complete costs, and timelines.
- B. A high number and diversity of students will be served by the enrichment opportunity.
- C. The enrichment opportunity will be an enhancement to student learning at Skyline not otherwise available through other means.
- D. The applicants clearly define how results of the enrichment opportunity will be communicated with the PTSA.

Application Evaluation Rubric

PTSA Student Enrichment Grant committee members will rate the applications based on the Primary Guidelines above using the following point scale:

- 0 pt. = does not meet and/or address guideline
- 1 pt. = minimally meets guideline
- 2 pt. = generally meets overall expectation of guideline
- 3 pt. = provides superior evidence of guideline

Applications receiving 8 or more points will be prioritized for funding.
